1 SCOPE OF DISCLOSURES

THIS CALIFORNIA PRIVACY POLICY (THE "CA POLICY") SUPPLEMENT THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN OUR <u>PRIVACY POLICY</u> AND APPLIES SOLELY TO INDIVIDUAL RESIDENTS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA ("CONSUMERS" OR "YOU").

THIS CA POLICY PROVIDE ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ABOUT HOW WE COLLECT, USE, DISCLOSE AND OTHERWISE PROCESS PERSONAL INFORMATION OF INDIVIDUAL RESIDENTS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, EITHER ONLINE OR OFFLINE, WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE CALIFORNIA CONSUMER PRIVACY ACT OF 2018 ("CCPA"), AS AMENDED.

UNLESS OTHERWISE EXPRESSLY STATED, ALL TERMS IN THIS CA POLICY HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS DEFINED IN OUR <u>PRIVACY POLICY</u> OR AS OTHERWISE DEFINED IN THE CCPA.

This CA Policy also does not apply to personal information relating to our employees, job applicants, and contractors, who will receive a separate privacy notice from us where required by law.

2 OUR PROCESSING OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

When we use the term "Personal Information" in this CA Policy, we mean information that identifies, relates to, describes, is reasonably capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a particular consumer or household.

The Right to Know	You have the right to request any or all the following information relating to the Personal Information we have collected about you or disclosed in the last 12 months, upon verification of your identity:

	☐ The business or commercial purposes for collecting or selling Personal Information about you.
The Right to Correct	You have the right to request that we correct in our records any Personal Information about you that is inaccurate.
The Right to Request Deletion	You have the right to request the deletion of Personal Information that we have collected from you, subject to certain exceptions.
The Right to Opt-Out of "Sales"	You have the right to opt out of the sale or sharing of your Personal Information with third parties for targeted advertising purposes, where such a "sale" or "sharing" is occurring (as such terms are defined by applicable law).
The Right to Limit Use/Disclosure of Sensitive Personal Information	You have the right to limit the use or disclosure of your sensitive Personal Information, where collected and as permitted under applicable law.
The Right to Non-Discrimination	You have the right not to receive discriminatory treatment for exercising any of the rights described above. However, please note that if the exercise of the rights described above limits our ability to process Personal Information (such as in



the case of a deletion request), we may no longer be able to provide you our products or services or engage with you in the same manner.

7.1 To Exercise Your Right to Know or Right to Deletion

We will need to verify your identity before processing your request. To verify your identity, we will generally either require the successful login to your account or the matching of sufficient information you provide us to the information we maintain about you in our systems. Although we try to limit the Personal Information collected in connection with a request to exercise the right to know or the right to deletion, certain requests may require us to obtain additional Personal Information from you. In certain circumstances, we may decline a request to exercise the right to know or right to deletion, particularly where we are unable to verify your identity.

Only you or a person that you authorize in writing to act on your behalf may make a verifiable consumer request related to your Personal Information. You (or your authorized agent) must provide documentation signed by you demonstrating that the agent is authorized to submit a verifiable consumer request on your behalf. If you make a verifiable request per the above, we will confirm our receipt and respond in the timeframes prescribed by the CCPA, typically within 45 days. We do not charge a different price or rate or provide a different level or quality of products or services based on you exercising your privacy rights.

7.2 To Exercise Your Right to Opt-Out of Personal Information Sales

As described above, we do not engage in sales of Personal Information; however, as a California resident, you may submit a request to opt-out of potential future sales under California law by emailing privacy@telesisbio.com with the subject line California Opt-Out Request. Please note we will take reasonable steps to verify your identity and the authenticity of the request. Once verified, we will maintain your request in the event our practices change.

7.3 Updates to This CA Policy

We will update this CA Policy from time to time. When we make changes to this CA Policy, we will change the effective date at the beginning of this CA Policy. If we make material changes to this CA Policy, we will notify you by email to your registered email address, by prominent posting on our online services, or through other appropriate communication channels. All changes shall be effective from the date of publication unless otherwise provided in the notification.
